

## Home Care Agency License Fees In Other Cash-Funded States

**California** – **\$5,368.52** per agency for initial and annual renewal of home health license. Personal care service agencies are not required to be licensed.

**Nevada** - **\$5,168** per home health office or subunit agency for the initial license.  
**\$2,584** per home health office or subunit for the annual renewal license.

**\$5,358** per home health branch office for an initial license.  
**\$2,679** per home health branch office for the annual renewal license

**\$1,374** for personal care services initial license.  
**\$ 687** for personal care services renewal license.

**Minnesota** - License fees vary depending on class of provider and provider revenue from prior year. Class A includes skilled services, while Class B provides personal care only.

Initial and annual renewal license fees for classes A & B are as set for below:

for revenues greater than \$1,500,000, **\$5,000.00**;  
for revenues greater than \$1,275,000 and no more than \$1,500,000, **\$4,375.00**;  
for revenues greater than \$1,100,000 and no more than \$1,275,000, **\$3,750.00**;  
for revenues greater than \$950,000 and no more than \$1,100,000, **\$3,125.00**;  
for revenues greater than \$850,000 and no more than \$950,000, **\$2,812.50**;  
for revenues greater than \$750,000 and no more than \$850,000, **\$2,500.00**;  
for revenues greater than \$650,000 and no more than \$750,000, **\$2,187.50**;  
for revenues greater than \$550,000 and no more than \$650,000, **\$1,875.00**;  
for revenues greater than \$450,000 and no more than \$550,000, **\$1,562.50**;  
for revenues greater than \$350,000 and no more than \$450,000, **\$1,250.00**;  
for revenues greater than \$250,000 and no more than \$350,000, **\$937.50**;  
for revenues greater than \$100,000 and no more than \$250,000, **\$625.00**;  
for revenues greater than \$25,000 and no more than \$100,000, **\$312.50**; and  
for revenues no more than \$25,000, **\$125.00**.

**Florida** - Initial and renewal two year license fee is **\$1,705**. However, licensees must also be accredited by ACHC, CHAP or the Joint Commission prior to licensure and maintain that accreditation in good standing throughout the licensure period.

**Washington** – License fee is based upon on the number of FTEs. See WAC 246-335-990 (set forth below)

Fees.

- (1) A licensee or applicant shall submit to the department:
  - (a) An initial 12-month license fee of \$2,162 for each service category for new persons not currently licensed in that category to provide in-home services in Washington state, or currently licensed businesses which have had statement of charges filed against them;
  - (b) A 24 month renewal fee based on the number of full-time equivalents (FTEs), which is a measurement based on a 40-hour week and is applicable to paid agency personnel or contractors, or the number of beds, as follows:
  - (c) For single service category licenses:

| # of FTEs   | Home Health       | Home Care         |

- (d) For multiple service category licenses:
  - (i) 100% of the home health category fee and 75% of the appropriate service category fee for each additional service category
  - (ii) 100% Of the hospice category fee and 75% percent of the appropriate service category fee for each additional service category (home care, hospice care center); and
- (e) A change of ownership fee of \$216 for each licensed service category. A new license will be issued and valid for the remainder of the current license period.

- (2) The department may charge and collect from a licensee a fee of **\$1,080** for:
  - (a) A second on-site visit resulting from failure of the licensee to adequately respond to a

statement of deficiencies:

- (b) A complete on-site survey resulting from a substantiated complaint; or
  - (c) A follow-up compliance survey.
- (3) A licensee with deemed status shall pay fees according to this section.
- (4) A licensee shall submit an additional late fee in the amount of \$36 per day, not to exceed \$550, from the renewal date (which is thirty days before the current license expiration date) until the date of mailing the fee, as evidenced by the postmark.

Home Health Agency License Fees In Other States that are Not Cash Funded

**New York - \$2,000** for initial and annual renewal.

**New Jersey - \$2,000** for initial and annual renewal plus **\$500** biennial inspection fee.
